SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) maintains a shooting range that primarily serves the purpose of training and qualification in firearms and tactics. Through agreements with other agencies, the range also serves over 30 municipal, county, state and federal law enforcement agencies on an annual basis with over 1,000 personnel using the range each year. The range provides static and motion targets, target frames, equipment storage, a simulated residential structure, and portable training aides such as simulated cover and concealment and a ramada area with tables for lecture.

The range is located near several facilities and entities that greatly enhance its usefulness. These include: the Northern Arizona Regional Training Academy, Central Yavapai Fire Training Academy and the Yavapai County Driving Track.


PVPD has been proactive in improvements to the range, including several grants which allowed for the installation of turning targets, electricity, water and buildings.

As law enforcement firearms applications have evolved to include the use of the urban patrol rifle and the precision rifle, PVPD recognized the need for a longer shooting range. We approached the Fain Signature Group several years ago, and they have agreed to donate over 4 acres of land to enable the construction of an approximately 200 yard range.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to accept title to Parcel #402-14-239T and record the deed, **OR** motion not to accept title to this property. **VOTE.**

OPTION ANALYSIS: The Town Council may accept title to the property and authorize recording the deed, **OR** decline to accept title to the property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends accepting this property for the Town of Prescott Valley.
