SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Town Code §10-02-060 provides for the Town Council to authorize consumption of alcohol for special events on Town property.

The Chamber of Commerce works closely with the Town’s Parks and Recreation Department to sponsor events at various Town locations pursuant to our annual Chamber contract. In accordance with past practice, a single approval for all of the planned Chamber events (up to 10 total) has been requested for the coming 2013 season. The Chamber of Commerce shall submit a separate Special Event License application to the State of Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control for each event. A Special Event Liquor Sales Business License shall be issued for each event by the Town Clerk’s office. Certificates of Insurance will be forwarded to the Town prior to each event date.

The Chamber of Commerce requests approval from Town Council for the 2013 seasonal Special Event Liquor Licenses to cover the following dates:

Battle of the Bands	May 18, 2013	Mountain Valley Amphitheater
Prescott Valley Days	June 13-16, 2013	Tim’s Toyota Center
Independence Day Celebration	July 4, 2013	Mountain Valley Park
Eco Loco Festival	September 7, 2013	Civic Center
Corn Hole Tournament	October 12, 2013	Civic Center
