SUMMARYBACKGROUND: The Town of Prescott Valley Primary Election was held on Tuesday, March 12, 2013. Said Election was held for the purpose of electing a Mayor, two (2) Council members for four-year terms and one (1) Council member for a two-year term. The ballot also offered forth two propositions/questions for the electorate’s consideration for adoption: 1. Proposition 422 - Alternative Expenditure Home Rule Option, and 2. Proposition 423 - *General Plan 2025*. The results of said election are detailed in the attached Resolution No. 1828. The All-Mail Ballot election was administered by the Election Department of Yavapai County per contract with the Town.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or in his absence, the Vice-Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1828 setting forth the official returns of the March 12, 2013 “All-Mail Ballot” Primary Election, **OR** Motion not to approve Resolution No. 1828. **VOTE.**
