Fair Housing Month

April 2013

Whereas, the Civic Rights Act of 1968 (commonly known as the Federal Fair Housing Act) and the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 prohibit discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing and financing of housing or land to be used for the construction of housing or in the provision of brokerage services on the basis of: race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status or national origin; and

Whereas, the 1968 and 1988 Federal Fair Housing Acts declare that it is a national policy to ensure equal opportunities in housing; and


Whereas, April has traditionally been designated as Fair Housing Month in the United States.


Now, therefore, I, Mayor Harvey C. Skoog of the Town of Prescott Valley, do hereby proclaim April as
