POPPY DAY May 24th & 25th, 2013

Whereas, America is the land of freedom, preserved and protected willingly and freely by citizen soldiers; and

Whereas, Millions who have answered the call have died on the field of battle; and

Whereas, a nation must be reminded of the price of war and the debt owed to those who have died in war; and

Whereas, the red poppy has been designated as the symbol of sacrifice of lives in all wars; and

Whereas, the American Legion Auxiliary has pledged to remind America annually of this debt through the distribution of this memorial flower;

Whereas, I, Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of the Town of Prescott Valley, do hereby proclaim May 24th & 25th, 2013 as:

"POPPY DAY"

and request all citizens to pay tribute to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the name of freedom by wearing the Memorial Poppy on that day.
