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**SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:** The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited DUI Task Force grant proposals to enhance impaired driving enforcement programs throughout Arizona for the 2013 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council's approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a project which targets identifying and taking enforcement action on impaired drivers to reduce injuries and fatalities throughout Prescott Valley.

On April 15, 2013, PVPD received notification from GOHS of an approved grant award funding the purchase of five (10) Portable Breath Testers with mouthpieces and miscellaneous phlebotomy supplies in the amount of \$5,763.55. The equipment will be utilized for the purpose of conducting DUI related enforcement activities which will assist the department in carrying out a comprehensive enforcement and public awareness program.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

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**OPTIONS ANALYSIS:** Council may either accept the GOHS Contract 2013-164-046 through Resolution No. 1835 **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

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**ACTION OPTION:** Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1835 accepting the GOHS Contract 2013-164-046 **OR** motion not to approve Resolution No. 1835. **VOTE.**

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1835 accepting the grant award.

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**FISCAL ANALYSIS:** There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor's Office of Highway Safety.
