

Adopt-A-Park Program

LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

Whereas, the Town of Prescott Valley embraces the Adopt-A-Park program, where a community group or organization participates as volunteers in the maintenance and improvements for a Town park site, and,

Whereas, The Ridge has expressed a desire to participate in this program with the understanding that:

1. The Ridge (including each member thereof) will assist in the upkeep and maintenance of the park, with the coordination of the Parks and Recreation Department.
2. The Ridge (including each member thereof) acknowledges that it has no authority to bind the Town of Prescott Valley for contractual obligations, expressed or implied.
3. The Ridge (including each member thereof) commits to conducting, at a minimum, one cleanup of its adopted site per month.
4. The Ridge (including each member thereof) expressly waives, releases and discharges any and all claims for damages of any kind (including personal injury), that is (and each of them) may have against the Town, its officials, officers, employees, agents, successors, and assigns, as a result of participating in this volunteer project. In so doing, it (and each of them) expressly assumes all of the risks of participating in this volunteer project and holds the Town harmless for, from, and against any and all claims for damages, including personal injury.

The Town, in turn, agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless The Ridge (including each member thereof) for, from and against any and all claims, including personal injury, arising from the negligence of

the Town, its officials, officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns.

Therefore, be it resolved that **The Ridge** is hereby appointed as an Adopt-A-Park trustee for Granville Park located on 5880 N. Bronco Lane in the Town of Prescott Valley this 27th day of June, 2013.
