SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Yavapai County Community Foundation (YCCF), an affiliate of the Arizona Community Foundation, supports a Law Enforcement Canine Fund. The scope of this fund is to exclusively benefit law enforcement organizations in Yavapai County that utilize canines for law enforcement purposes, including but not limited to, patrol tracking, locating illegal drugs, search and rescue, and locating cadavers. Each year, YCCF solicits requests for proposals to fund local canine programs. Funds are intended to support the acquisition, implementation and maintenance of canines; collaborative training and educational opportunities; and initial or specialty training for the canines and/or their handlers.

In March, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted a grant proposal to support the enhancement of the department's K9 Program. On July 1st, PVPD received notice that the YCCF grant committee awarded funds in the amount of \$10,468 for the program. The department will use these funds to purchase a police service dog, and canine specialty supplies.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: The Town Council may either accept the grant award from the Yavapai County Community Foundation and approve the Law Enforcement Canine Fund Grant Contract # 20141330, or decline the grant award.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve the Law Enforcement Canine Fund Grant Contract # 20141330 accepting the grant award, **OR** Motion not to accept the grant award. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approving the Law Enforcement Canine Fund Grant Contract # 20141330 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully funded through the Yavapai County Community Foundation Law Enforcement Canine Fund in the amount of \$10,468.
