Dear Friends:

I hereby confirm that Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Prescott Valley, Arizona (Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) congregation code 30150; U.S. federal employer identification number 86-0689076) is listed on the official roster of congregations of the ELCA. As a congregation of this church, Emmanuel Lutheran Church is covered by the Group Exemption Number assigned to the ELCA. The number is 9386.

Emmanuel Lutheran Church is listed on page 20 of the Group Exemption List filed with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) by this church in November 1996.

This four-digit Group Exemption Number indicates that the ELCA and its related entities are recognized as exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Group Exemption Number is the same for the ELCA, its synods, its congregations, and its related entities.

The nine-digit Employer Identification Number is different for each synod, for each congregation, and for other employing entities. The nine-digit number is used, for example, when federal withholding and Social Security contributions are filed by the employer.

This assignment of the four-digit group exemption number to the ELCA and its related entities does not change the previously assigned Employer Identification Number that synods, congregations and other organizations already have.

Enclosed are the April 5, 1988, group exemption letter issued to ELCA by the IRS and the July 13, 1988, IRS letter assigning the group exemption number.

Dear Applicant:

Additionally, we have classified the organizations you operate, supervise, or control, and which are covered by your notification to us as organizations that are not private foundations because they are organizations of the type described in Sections 509(a)(1) 509(a)(2) or 509(a)(3) of the Code.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinates as provided in Section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for Federal Estate and Gift Tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of Sections 2055, 2106 and 2522 of the Code.
