National American Indian Heritage Month November 2013

WHEREAS, the ASDAR, Yavapai Chapter of Prescott Valley, Arizona is sponsoring National American Indian Heritage Month in the Tri-City area during the Month of November 2013; and

WHEREAS, the history and culture of our great nation have been significantly influenced by American Indians and indigenous peoples; and

WHEREAS, the contributions of American Indians have enhanced the freedom, prosperity, and greatness of America today; and

WHEREAS, their customs and traditions are respected and celebrated as part of a rich legacy throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, Native American Awareness Week began in 1976 and recognition was expanded by Congress and approved by President George Bush in August 1990, designating the month of November as National American Indian Heritage Month; and

WHEREAS, in honor of National American Indian Heritage Month, community celebrations; as well as numerous cultural, artistic, educational, and historical activities have been planned;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, do hereby declare November 2013 as:
