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**SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:** The Governor’s Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited grant proposals to enhance highway safety programs throughout Arizona for the 2014 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council’s approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a comprehensive program which focuses on preventing and taking enforcement action on DUI and errant driving behaviors utilizing various methods throughout Prescott Valley.

On September 24, 2013, PVPD received notification from GOHS of a grant award providing funds in the amount of \$25,000 for DUI enforcement and education. The funds will be utilized for the purpose of conducting educational and enforcement activities throughout the award period of October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014. Funds will support personnel services (overtime) and employee related expenses to enhance DUI enforcement and education.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

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**OPTIONS ANALYSIS:** Council may either accept the GOHS Contract 2014-AL-007 through Resolution No. 1855, **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

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**ACTION OPTION:** Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1855 accepting the GOHS Contract 2014-AL-007, **OR** Motion not to approve Resolution No. 1855. **VOTE.**

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1855 accepting the grant award.

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**FISCAL ANALYSIS:** There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor’s Office of Highway Safety.
