WHEREAS, libraries, librarians, library workers and supporters across America are celebrating National Library Week.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of Prescott Valley, do hereby proclaim April 13 - 19, 2014 as:

“National Library Week”


and encourage all residents to visit the library this week to take advantage of the wonderful library resources available at your library. Lives change at your library.
