*Whereas, the American Legion Auxiliary has pledged to remind America annually of this debt through the distribution of this memorial flower;*






*and request all citizens to pay tribute to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the name of freedom by wearing the Memorial Poppy on that day.*
