
Now, therefore, I, Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of the Town of Prescott Valley, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2014 as:

"NATIONAL WATER SAFETY MONTH"


in Prescott Valley, and I urge all citizens to support and promote this observance.
