SUMMARY BACKGROUND: The Town of Prescott Valley has historically funded the Trauma Intervention Program (TIP) to provide emotional and practical support to the victims of traumatic events. Many times police officers leave these victims in the hands of trained counselors from TIP. TIP received funding in the amount of \$13,005 for FY 2013-2014. The same level of funding is proposed for FY 14-15.

These funds will be used to provide services that will make available to the Town sufficient information to contact the appropriate volunteers during events that could prove traumatic for Prescott Valley residents. Employees and volunteers will provide necessary equipment and vehicles and provide on-scene emotional and practical support to the victims of traumatic events.

This Agreement includes a requirement that Trauma Intervention Programs, Inc. provide a quarterly report outlining how the Town's financial contribution was utilized, and a requirement that it provide an annual financial report to the Town.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may approve the Agreement, or direct staff to make modifications to the Agreement before approval.
