The Town may, at its option, retain an outside vendor to conduct a background check of each applicant or require any or all applicants to submit a full set of fingerprints for the purpose of obtaining a state and federal criminal history of an applicant. Every offer extended to volunteers will be conditioned upon the successful completion of a background and/or fingerprint check.
