SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited grant proposals to enhance highway safety programs throughout Arizona for the 2015 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council's approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a comprehensive program which focuses on preventing and taking enforcement action on DUI and errant driving behaviors utilizing various methods throughout Prescott Valley.

On August 13, 2014, PVPD received notification from GOHS of a grant award providing funds in the amount of \$21,995.00 for accident investigation equipment. The funds will be utilized for the purpose of conducting accident investigation and enforcement activities throughout the award period of October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015. Funds will support the purchase of a Sokkia LEA remote mapper. The purchase of this equipment will enhance traffic collision investigations for subsequent enforcement efforts.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the GOHS Contract 2015-IA-005 through Resolution No. 1891, **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1891 accepting the GOHS Contract 2015-IA-005. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1891 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor's Office of Highway Safety.
