The Prescott Valley Police Department and the Town of Prescott Valley (Lessor), of Yavapai County, Arizona agrees to lease one police vehicle, listed above, to the Yavapai Regional Medical Center (Security Department), of Prescott Valley (Lessee).

The Town of Prescott Valley makes no claims; warranty expressed or implied, or promises as to soundness, condition or suitability of the above listed vehicle. The Lessor has disclosed and provided all information available regarding the soundness, condition and suitability of said vehicle to the Lessee.

The Town of Prescott Valley agrees to transfer the above listed vehicle responsibility to Yavapai Regional Medical Center Security Department for \$1.00 yearly. The Yavapai Regional Medical Center agrees to accept liability, responsibility, care and control of the above listed vehicle. The Yavapai Regional Medical Center Security Department agrees to waive and hold harmless the Prescott Valley Police Department, the Town of Prescott Valley, its employees, agents and officials from any claim of liability, injury or damage arising from temporary ownership of the vehicle. Lessor accepts the terms and conditions understanding that the Lease will commence after the signing of this lease agreement and will run indefinitely or until a common understanding is reached by both parties as to the continued usefulness of the vehicle. Payment will be due at the commencement of this contract and subsequently on the first of January each year. It is further understood that the Lessee may make necessary alterations to the vehicle to include but not limited to YRMC decals etc.
