SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The 100 Club of Arizona is a non-profit organization that provides immediate financial assistance to public safety officers and firefighters who are seriously injured or killed in the line of duty and to provide resources to enhance their safety and well-being. For several years, the Prescott Valley Police Department has partnered with the 100 Club of Arizona in achieving their mission.

The Prescott Valley Police Department applied for the 1st quarter Safety Enhancement Stipend in order to continue our successful endeavors in their campaign for officer safety. On May 18, 2015, the Prescott Valley Police Department received notice of an approved stipend award from the 100 Club of Arizona for \$4,000.00. Funding will be utilized to purchase safety equipment, two portable ballistic shields.

If accepted, this stipend will commence on May 18, 2015 and will terminate on July 18, 2015.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either approve the 100 Club of Arizona Safety Enhancement Stipend Award OR decline the stipend award.
