SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Arizona Automobile Theft Authority (AATA) enhances officer's awareness by awarding grants through its Public Awareness Grant Program. A vital component in the AATA's mission is officer awareness and community education. Arizona Automobile Theft Authority professional training will heighten auto theft enforcement and investigation skills by obtaining advanced officer training which will enhance officer's knowledge and efforts for investigating related offenses.

The Prescott Valley Police Department applied for FY15/16 AATA grant funding in order for officers to attend auto theft training. On May 22, 2015, the Prescott Valley Police Department received notice of an approved grant award from AATA for \$1,105.75. Funding will be utilized to attend the International Association of Auto Theft Investigators 63rd Annual Training and lodging.

If accepted, this grant agreement will commence on July 1, 2015 and will terminate on June 30, 2016

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the Arizona Automobile Theft Authority (AATA) Professional Training 2015/2016 Public Awareness Grant Award OR decline the grant award.
