

Resolution No. 1923

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION REQUESTING FEDERAL FUNDING TO ACCOMPLISH ESSENTIAL TASKS ASSOCIATED WITH A WATERSMART DEVELOPMENT OF FEASIBILITY STUDIES UNDER THE TITLE XVI WATER RECLAMATION AND REUSE PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, the Town of Prescott Valley (“Town”) desires to partner with the Bureau of Reclamation to forward its goals for improved water management; and

WHEREAS, the Town further seeks outside funding to support its goals and planned activities; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the professional expertise and financial ability to successfully implement the grant, including adherence to deadlines and reporting requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Town understands its financial responsibility and has the resources, as included in the Project Budget, to meet the fifty percent (50%) match requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Town staff is hereby authorized to make application to the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation and, specifically, for Project Director John Munderloh (Water Resources Manager) to take all necessary steps to complete and submit said application.

2. That this Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
