

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1962**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY STATE-SHARED REVENUE PROGRAM FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Prescott Valley (TOWN) is desirous of undertaking activities that will benefit the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community, in accordance with Proposition 202, through their State-Shared Revenue Program, provides funds to cities, towns and counties for government services that benefit the general public concentrating on the areas of public safety, transportation, health care, economic development and education; and

WHEREAS, the TOWN and Yavapai Big Brothers Big Sisters are proposing to identify and match 100 vulnerable youth with a Big Brother Big Sister or Couple/ Family Match "Bigs", and the activities within this proposal address one or more of the priority funding areas, and

WHEREAS, grantees of the Gila River Indian Community State-Shared Revenue Program funds are required to comply with the program process and procedures as set forth by the Gila River Indian Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, ARIZONA, THAT:

1. The TOWN hereby approves the submission of an application for Gila River Indian Community State-Shared Revenue Program funds.
2. The TOWN agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the Gila River Indian Community.
3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to direct and execute all documents so as to fulfill this application and completion of the projects therein.
