SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Casey Van Haren submitted a grant to the Arizona State Library Archives and Public Records which was approved and funded. The Peak Experience Business Hub, in partnership with Yavapai Regional Economic Development and Northern Arizona University-Yavapai, will provide free workshops for local business owners or those wanting to start a business. Workshop topics will include, Practical Entrepreneurship, Intro to Business Plan Writing, Crowdfunding for Small Business, and many more. There will also be opportunities to receive free one-on-one business counseling from experienced business professionals and Lunch-n-Learn seminars.
