## Yavapai County Fallen Military Memorial

June 14, 2016

*WHEREAS, some 186 veterans of the armed forces from Yavapai County have given their lives in various wars in defense of freedom; and*

*WHEREAS, the Town of Prescott Valley and Yavapai County as a whole should honor their service and sacrifice in perpetuity; and*

*WHEREAS, a plaque known as the "All-Veterans Memorial Plaque" mounted on the Yavapai County Courthouse grounds in Prescott will be updated on June 14, 2016; and*

*WHEREAS, a Veteran and Graduate of Bradshaw Mountain High School in Prescott Valley, Arizona **Pvt. Reece David Moreno** sacrificed his life on November 24, 2006 while serving with the United States Army in Iraq. His name will be added to this plaque in honor and remembrance of his service and ultimate sacrifice.*

***NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** I Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of the Town of Prescott Valley, do hereby encourage the citizens of Prescott Valley to honor one of our own, **Pvt. Reece David Moreno**, and all those who have fallen in military service to our nation during times of war by flying the United States flag at half-staff and pausing for a moment of silence at twelve noon on the fourteenth day of June, 2016, in remembrance of their heroic sacrifice.*


