SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Several months ago the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) had a vehicle used for traffic enforcement involved in a collision and it was subsequently deemed a total loss. The insurance payoff, coupled with some additional monies we had on hand that has been dedicated for traffic enforcement, is not enough to purchase a replacement vehicle.

Subsequently, we submitted a formal request for Governor’s Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) funds in the amount of \$30,000.00. These funds will be combined with the funds we have and will enable us to purchase a replacement vehicle to be used for traffic enforcement to include general traffic violations and specifically those infractions that contribute to an unsafe community such as DUI enforcement and seat belt violations.

On May 23, 2016, PVPD received notification from GOHS of a grant award providing funds in the amount of \$30,000.00 for one (1) fully marked police package vehicle to enhance DUI/Impaired Driving Enforcement and Selective Traffic Enforcement (STEP) throughout the Town of Prescott Valley. The funds will be utilized for the purpose of conducting enforcement activities throughout the award period of October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the GOHS Contract 2016-405d-016 through Resolution No. 1968, **OR** decline to adopt the resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1968 accepting the GOHS Contract 2016-405d-016. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1968 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: The Police Department currently has \$21,397 in the replacement fund (201-0000-476-0100) to use towards this vehicle purchase. These funds were acquired through the sale of 3 patrol motorcycles and the insurance funds from a totaled 2004 Chevy Impala patrol vehicle that was involved

in an accident. These funds, coupled with the \$30,000.00 in GOHS grant funds will be utilized to purchase the traffic enforcement vehicle.
