

SUMMARY BACKGROUND: The ½ cent sales tax initiated in January 2016 provides additional maintenance dollars for the 260 miles of asphaltic roadway in the Town. A pavement overlay is a maintenance treatment that enhances the pavement life cycle and structural integrity. The FY 2016/17 Streets maintenance budget for pavement overlay has the Viewpoint Dr. & Roundup Dr. segment proposed for an asphalt overlay.

The pavement overlay project proposes to rehabilitate Viewpoint Drive/Roundup Drive from Addis Avenue to Robert Road through the application of a two inch pavement overlay. The project will also include the application of a high volume chip seal and striping.



On Monday, June 27, 2016, the Town received a total of five (5) bids for construction services as follows:

The engineering consultant for the project (Dava & Associates, Inc.) has reviewed the bids and recommends award to the lowest responsive bidder, Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc., in the total amount of

\$330,220.00. Award of this Bid is within the budget funds available. Construction is scheduled to begin Monday, July 25, 2016, and will last approximately 21 days.

This action is also for the consideration of approval of an Amendment to the Town Engineer Agreement with Dava & Associates for additional design and construction period services in an amount not to exceed \$20,290.00.
