WHEREAS, an increase in community awareness is necessary to put a stop to the diabetes epidemic.


NOW THEREFORE, I, Harvey C. Skoog, Mayor of the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, do hereby declare November 2016 as:

“American Diabetes Month”


