SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Secretary of Defense is authorized to transfer to State Law Enforcement Agencies, Department of Defense (DOD) property that is excess to the needs of the (DOD), and that the Secretary determines is suitable to be used by such agencies in law enforcement activities, with preferences for counter-drug / counter-terrorism or border security activities. The State of Arizona administers this program for all Arizona law enforcement agencies.

This Memorandum of Understanding between the State of Arizona and the Town would allow for the transfer of excess DOD property, such as protective gear and tactical vehicles, at no cost to the Town.

The Town of Prescott Valley has benefitted from this program through receipt of firearms, ballistic armor, vehicles and other equipment to improve the quality of service it provides to the community.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may approve this MOU with the State of Arizona or not approve the MOU.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the Town and the State of Arizona for participation in the Department of Defense Procurement Program, **OR** Motion not to approve this MOU. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the MOU.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is a yearly membership fee in the amount of \$250 that has already been budgeted in the PD FY 16/17 budget.
