

RESOLUTION NO. 1981

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, SETTING FORTH THE OFFICIAL RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION OF THE TOWN, DULY CALLED AND HELD ON THE 8th DAY OF NOVEMBER 2016, AS A POLLING CENTER ELECTION; DECLARING THE APPROVAL OF PROPOSITION 440 THE 2016-INIT.002 INITIATIVE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, duly called and held its General Election pursuant to ARS §9-821.01(a) and Town Code §2-03-010; and

WHEREAS, said General Election was conducted on November 8, 2016 as a Polling Center Election in accordance with ARS §16-409; and

WHEREAS, said General Election was held for the purpose of the electorate considering the passage of Proposition 440 - Initiative 2016-INIT.002 proposed by the citizens ; and

WHEREAS, the qualified electors did cast a total of 24,321 ballots; and

WHEREAS, the County Recorder of Yavapai County provided election services for the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Official Final Results of the General Election have been reported to the Town Clerk from the Elections Department of the Yavapai County Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with §9-821 and Article 11, Chapter 4, Title 16 of the ARS, it is required that the Mayor and Council canvas said election returns and enter the same as an official record of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Prescott Valley, as follows:

Section 1. That it be hereby declared that the following Proposition 440, "No Sales Tax Increases without Voter Approval", was approved by the qualified electors of the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, having received approval votes on a majority of ballots cast in the General Election on November 8, 2016.

NO 2,741 14%

Section 9. The OFFICIAL RESULTS from the General Election held on November 8, 2016, show the following number of rejected ballots:
