SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: On October 31, 2009 two terms came up for renewal on the Planning and Zoning Commission; Keith Burley and Ben Harper.

Keith Burley was appointed to his first term on the Planning and Zoning Commission in June of 2005 replacing Phil Bourdon who resigned June 2005. This re-appointment will be Keith Burley's 3rd consecutive term. Ben Harper was appointed to his first term on the Planning and Zoning Commission in October of 2005 replacing Charles Musarra who resigned September 2005. This re-appointment will be Ben Harper's 3rd consecutive term.

Keith Burley and Ben Harper submitted renewal application letters to be reappointed. Vice-Mayor Lora Lee Nye, Council member Flannery and Council member Schumacher are recommending the re-appointments of Keith Burley and Ben Harper to terms with a renewal date of October 31, 2012.
