SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited DUI Task Force grant proposals to enhance impaired driving enforcement programs throughout Arizona for the 2010 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council's approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a project which targets identifying and taking enforcement action on impaired drivers to reduce injuries and fatalities throughout Prescott Valley.

On November 19, 2009, PVPD received notification from GOHS of an approved grant award funding training expenses in the amount of \$3,080. Funds will specifically support the out-of-state travel expenses incurred for sending four (4) participants to the 16th IACP Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) Training Conference on Drugs, Alcohol and Impaired Driving scheduled in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania in August 2010. This annual training conference has kept DRE's and other health and safety professionals up-to-date on drug trends, legal issues and innovative technology. In addition to general sessions featuring the latest research and initiatives, daily workshops will address a variety of topics relevant to law enforcement, toxicology, prosecutors and other traffic safety advocates. This annual training assists PVPD in carrying out the objectives of a comprehensive enforcement and public awareness program.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the GOHS 2010 Arizona DUI Task Force Grant Award (Contract # 2010-410-009) through Resolution No. 1678 **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1678 accepting the 2010 GOHS Arizona DUI Task Force Grant Award (Contract # 2010-410-009). **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1678 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor's Office of Highway Safety.
