SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Governor’s Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) recently solicited grant proposals to enhance underage drinking enforcement programs throughout Arizona for the 2010 Federal Fiscal Year. Through Council’s approval, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) submitted an application to receive funding for a program which focuses on preventing and taking enforcement action on underage drinking violations throughout Prescott Valley.

On November 23, 2009, PVPD received notification from GOHS of an approved grant award funding personnel services (overtime) and employee related expenses in the amount of \$2,500. Funds will be utilized for the purpose of conducting underage drinking prevention and enforcement activities which will greatly enhance PVPD’s efforts in maintaining a pro-active approach to these issues. Efforts include theatre advertisements which display youth-alcohol awareness and information messages; the “Every Fifteen Minutes” campaign; party patrols; and the participation in various other enforcement details related to underage drinking.

Acceptance of the Highway Safety Contract requires a certified Council Resolution authorizing entry into the contract with GOHS.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the GOHS 2010 Arizona DUI Task Force Grant Award (Contract # 2010-HFR-002) through Resolution No. 1679 **or** decline to adopt the resolution.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1679 accepting the 2010 GOHS Arizona DUI Task Force Grant Award (Contract # 2010-HFR-002). **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1679 accepting the grant award.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor’s Office of Highway Safety.
