SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: On December 1, 2009, the Prescott Valley Police Department (PVPD) received notice of three (3) grant awards from the Arizona Department of Homeland Security totaling an amount of \$66,068.61 for various projects under the FFY 2007 Homeland Security Grant Program. These awards stem from the reissuance of unused funds previously awarded to other agencies for Homeland Security initiatives.

The department is seeking Council's acceptance of these grant awards and the approval to make the following purchases in their respective amounts:

- Grant Agreement No. 333512-03 Improved Interoperable Handheld Radio Communications
 - Purchase of P-25 capable MOTOTRBO VHF 160 channel analog/digital radio equipment with accessories in the amount of \$10,443
- Grant Agreement No. 333512-04 Improved Interoperable Handheld Radio Communications
 - Purchase of P-25 capable MOTOTRBO VHF 160 channel analog/digital radio equipment with accessories in the amount of \$41,117.61
- Grant Agreement No. 333512-05 CBRNE-Interperimeter Mobile Command Post Vehicle Equipment
 - Purchase of equipment for the Command Post vehicle to provide on-scene lighting, auxillary power and other necessary tools for communication and operation of the vehicle in the amount of \$14,508.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either accept the grant awards and approve the authorized grant purchases in their respective amounts or deny the grant award and respective purchases.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to accept the grant awards and approve the authorized grant purchases in their respective amounts. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends accepting the grant awards and approving the authorized grant purchases in their respective amounts.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. These purchases are fully funded and reimbursed on a quarterly basis by the Arizona Department of Homeland Security in the awarded amounts.
