SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: As part of the development criteria for Stoneridge Subdivision, the Town of Prescott Valley accepts maintenance of specified multi-use pathway upon construction completion meeting Town acceptance. The multi-use pathway to be accepted runs through Stoneridge Units 5, 6, 7 and 8. This particular multi-use pathway provides for continuous connection and non-vehicular transportation capability for public use.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: The Council may vote to:

- 1.) Approve the Easement, **OR**
- 2.) Not approve the Easement, **AND/OR**
- 3.) Direct staff to pursue other options.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve the easement of the multi-use path in Stoneridge. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the easement conveyance for transfer of maintenance of the multi-use pathway through Stoneridge Units 5, 6, 7 and 8.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is not a direct fiscal impact as a result of approving this easement with the exception of minor recording fees and a minimal payment of \$10.00.
