Dear Mr. Stanton:

Yavapai County would like to accept the invitation from the Town of Prescott Valley for the allowing of two small County communities that are within the Town of Prescott Valley's urban area to participate in the Town's Spring Clean-up Days (April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>). The residents of the unincorporated areas of Castle Canyon Mesa and Prescott Country Club were appreciative of the County and Town's last clean-up effort, which proved to be a great success.

The Yavapai County Board of Supervisors and Development Services Director Steven Mauk would like to give their support to this project and will provide County personnel to assist at the dump site.

Yavapai County will provide to the residents of Castle Canyon Mesa and Prescott Country Club adult probationers to help the elderly and physically challenged lift and move heavy trash bags.

It has been decided that due to budget constraints and high volumes of commercial dumping that a fee for clean up days will continue. The attached flyer will show the costs per type of vehicle using the dump site. Yavapai County vehicle's that are assisting the elderly and physically challenged with trash removal will not pay a fee to enter into the Town's dump site. As previously discussed, Yavapai County will compensate to the Town of Prescott Valley its portion of the total cost minus the collected fees as a percentage of users from Castle Canyon Mesa and Prescott Country Club to the entire Town's participation. To illustrate, if Prescott Country Club and Castle Canyon Mesa participation was 15% of the total participation and the total cost for the Town of Prescott Valley was \$60,000, subtract the collected fees of \$20,000, leaving \$40,000 total cost, Yavapai County would make payment to the Town of Prescott Valley for 15% of \$40,000 being \$6,000.
