SUMMARY: The Prescott Valley Police Department wishes to enter into a license agreement with Foxworth-Galbraith Lumber Company which would allow the police department usage of their facilities located at 11540 E. Santa Fe Loop Road in Prescott Valley. The facilities will be used expressly for storage of equipment and police training. The buildings at the location are not currently occupied and can provide covered, enclosed storage for safe guarding of equipment. The facility is also an ideal location for tactical training scenarios by our SWAT and K9 Teams.

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may either approve the licensing agreement with Foxworth-Galbraith or deny entering into agreement.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to approve entering into the licensing agreement with Foxworth-Galbraith Lumber Company. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approving the licensing agreement for use of the facilities for storage and training.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is a fiscal impact of \$1.00 to enter into the license agreement. This expense can be absorbed within the police department's FY10/11 Budget.
