

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Town was successful in obtaining Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grants through the AZ Department of Transportation (ADOT) for Phases II & III of the SR 69 Multi-use Path from Glassford Hill Road to Great Western Dr. A TE Grant in 2005 for Phase II is in the amount of \$891,978.00, and a Grant in 2007 for Phase III is in the amount of \$1,017,950.00. Under applicable federal regulations, ADOT is responsible for leading the design and construction management while involving the Town throughout. Both projects have now been combined for one project design effort, and eventual construction, to gain efficiencies and construction economy.

Project plans are 100% complete and ready for contractor bid. Prior to beginning construction, ADOT requires Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA's) with the Town to identify ADOT funding & construction responsibilities but Town maintenance of the multi-use path when construction is complete. There is also a requirement that the Town provide complete indemnification of liability to the state, even though they are primarily responsible for design and construction. A separate IGA is required for each phase: Phase II (Glassford to Starlight) and Phase III (Starlight to Great Western). Multi-use path construction completion is anticipated in the Spring of 2011 and, coupled with Phase I, it will provide 2.57 miles of multi-use path on SR 69 between Navajo Dr. and Great Western Dr.



OPTION ANALYSIS: The Council may vote to:

- 1.) Approve these Intergovernmental Agreements with ADOT, **OR**
- 2.) Not approve these Intergovernmental Agreements with ADOT, **AND/OR**
- 3.) Direct staff to pursue other options

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement with ADOT for design, construction and maintenance of the SR 69 Multi-use Path Phase III (Starlight to Great Western), **OR** Motion not to approve this Intergovernmental Agreement. **VOTE**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the approval of this Intergovernmental Agreement with ADOT for Phase III of the SR 69 Multi-use path.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: Although there are a number of Town obligations being undertaken through this IGA, it is believed that the continued development of the SR 69 Multi-use Path could not have been completed without agreeing to undertake these obligations.
