Dear Mayor Skoog:

It was great meeting with you for lunch during your recent visit to Northcentral University. Our meetings always provide me with a better understanding of the issues that are impacting our community. I continue to applaud your leadership and the efforts of the Town Council, in working to provide a high quality way of life for all of our residents.

As a follow-up to our recent meeting on the Northcentral University course surcharge tax, we discussed our joint plans for the use of these dollars in 2011. In our discussions, I expressed the University's desire to use half (50%) of the proceeds to support the new Breast Cancer Center at the Yavapai Regional Medical Center. As you know, this is an important facility that is providing value added benefits to our community. As an employer with approximately 60% female employee population, we believe that strong support on our part, as well as a strong commitment from the Town, is needed as this facility ramps up to serve the many needs in our community.

While the University is focused on half of the funding being made available to the Breast Cancer Center, we also recognize that the Town does have other important community priorities that must be addressed. As a result, we would request that you and the Council decide what projects and activities are worthy of funding with the remaining 50% that comes from this surcharge tax.

In addition, sometime during the fall, I will schedule a time for Tim Barnett, or his designated representative, to meet with us to discuss the process that we will use to send the designated surcharge tax allocation to the Yavapai Regional Medical Center in 2011.

Mayor, thank you for your continued support of our institution. Northcentral University is very pleased to be able to provide some financial support in an effort to help improve the quality of life for the residents of Prescott Valley, and we are especially pleased to call the Town of Prescott Valley our home!
