SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: On August 27, Governor Jan Brewer released program guidance for the Public Safety Stabilization Program, a grant program established using the Governor's State Fiscal Stabilization Fund (SFSF) Discretionary monies allocated from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009. Governor Brewer previously authorized the utilization of \$10 million of SFSF from the ARRA of 2009 to fund the grant program. The intent of allocating these monies to the grant program is to afford public safety agencies the resources needed to provide safety and security in their local communities given the nationwide downturn in revenues at all levels of government. Eligible jurisdictions include counties, incorporated cities and towns, tribal nations and independent fire districts.

The Prescott Valley Police Department wishes to partake in this grant opportunity by applying for local funding. Our jurisdiction is eligible to apply for funds in an amount up to \$99,999. The grant period is a one-time, 12 month, non-renewable contract. With Council's approval, the department is proposing the submittal of an application for the following:
