SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: AZLink is a statewide law enforcement program for sharing information about crime and criminal activities among various local, state, and federal agencies. The Maricopa County Sheriff's office has been designated as the Subgrantee agency for reimbursement of funds for AZLink from the State Homeland Security Grant Program of the Arizona Department of Homeland Security.

On September 23, 2010, the Council approved the original Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for the Police Department to join as a client agency in this program with Maricopa County. The next step in implementing this program is completion of the AZLink data source connections.

The original IGA anticipated that grant funding might be available to client agencies to address the cost of acquiring and maintaining the required hardware and software. Such grant funding has been identified, and a second IGA related to that grant is now proposed. The combined cost presently associated with the program is \$45,000, divided equally between the Prescott Valley Police Department and the Prescott Police Department (i.e., \$22,500 per department).

OPTION ANALYSIS: The Council may vote to:

- 1.) Approve this second IGA that provides \$22,500 in grant funding for participation in AZLink, **OR**
- 2.) Not approve this IGA, **AND/OR**
- 3.) Direct staff to pursue other options

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve this second Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for grant funding for participation in AZLink, **OR** Motion not to approve this Intergovernmental Agreement. **VOTE**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of this second Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for grant funding for participation in AZLink.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: The costs associated with this segment of the AZLink program implementation are of the amounts approved from prior discussions and known to be available by grant funding.
