SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: On September 23, 2010, the Council voted to submit an application for funding under the Public Safety Stabilization Program of the Arizona Office of Economic Recovery. Eligible jurisdictions included counties, incorporated cities and towns, tribal nations and independent fire districts. The intent of allocating these monies to the grant program is to afford public safety agencies the resources needed to provide safety and security in their local communities given the nationwide downturn in revenues at all levels of government.

On October 20, Governor Jan Brewer informed us the department has been awarded a Governor's State Fiscal Stabilization Fund Grant in the amount of \$50,000 for the period Of October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011. The Prescott Valley Police Department wishes to partake in this grant opportunity by accepting the monies for local funding. The grant period is a one-time, 12 month, non-renewable contract. With Council's approval, the department will apply the funds as indicated below:

OPTIONS ANALYSIS: The Town Council may either enter into the IGA required to accept the grant award from the Governor's State Fiscal Stabilization Fund, or decline to enter into the IGA required for the grant award.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Arizona required to accept the grant award from the Governor's State Fiscal Stabilization Fund, **OR** Motion not to accept the grant award. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends entering into the IGA required to accept the grant award from Governor's State Fiscal Stabilization Fund.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There is no fiscal impact to the Town. This grant is fully reimbursable through the Governor's Office Economic Recovery in the amount of \$50,000.
