

RESOLUTION NO. 1735

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, ADOPTING A MINOR AMENDMENT TO THE TOWN'S *GENERAL PLAN 2020* (GPA010-002) PURSUANT TO ARS §9-461.06 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A NEW GUIDING PRINCIPLE "CIR-B" WITHIN THE CIRCULATION ELEMENT OF THE *GENERAL PLAN 2020*; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, the Prescott Valley Town Council first adopted a "Comprehensive Plan" for the Town by Resolution No. 69 on September 25, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted a new "Prescott Valley General Plan and Implementation Guide" by Resolution No. 529 on January 27, 1994; and

WHEREAS, through adoption of the "Growing Smarter Act" (1998 Ariz. Sess. Laws, Chap. 204, §21) as amended by 1999 Ariz. Sess. Laws, Chap. 222, §2, the Arizona Legislature required the Town to amend its General Plan in accordance with the Act (as amended by "Growing Smarter Plus", 2000 Ariz. Sess. Laws Chap. 1) by December 31, 2002; and

WHEREAS, after an extensive public process, a draft "Prescott Valley *General Plan 2020*" was considered by the Prescott Valley Planning and Zoning Commission at public hearings held on December 10, 2001 at the Prescott Valley Civic Center and December 11, 2001 at the Glassford Hill Middle School, resulting in a vote by the Commission to recommend adoption of the same by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council considered the "Prescott Valley *General Plan 2020*" at a public hearing held January 17, 2002, and adopted the same by Resolution No. 1066 [subject to ratification by the voters per ARS §9-461.06(L)]; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2002, the Prescott Valley *General Plan 2020* was ratified by the voters; and

WHEREAS, the criteria for determining whether a proposed amendment to the *General Plan 2020* is a major or minor amendment is set forth in Sections 10.2.1 and 10.2.2 of the *General Plan 2020*, in accordance with ARS §9-461.06; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements for Minor General Plan Amendments, the Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on said application (GPA10-002) at its regular meeting on September 13, 2010, and voted to forward the same to the Town Council with a recommendation of approval, and the Council subsequently held a second public hearing on the application at its regular meeting on _____; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that this Minor General Plan Amendment will establish a process to have plans adopted by the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization (CYMPO) Board become part of the recommendations of the Circulation Element

in accordance with a new Guiding Principal “B” (with corresponding Goals and Policies) be added in Chapter 5 through this Minor General Plan Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona, as follows:

1. That the Prescott Valley *General Plan 2020* be hereby amended to include in Chapter 5, Circulation Element a new Guiding Principal CIR-B as follows:

GUIDING PRINCIPLE CIR-B: ADMINISTRATIVELY UPDATE CHAPTER 5, THE CIRCULATION ELEMNET OF THE GENERAL PLAN 2020 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE YAVAPAI COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND UPDATES PREPARED AND APPROVED BY THE CENTRAL YAVAPAI METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (CYMPO).

GOAL: CIR-B1 *Make part of the General Plan 2020 relevant transportation related studies and plans approved by CYMPO.*

POLICIES: CIR-B1.1 *Include as an addendum to the Circulation Element of the General Plan 2020 any planning study or document approved by the CYMPO Executive Board related to circulation and transportation in Prescott Valley*

2. That this Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
