**CANIDATE INTERVIEW QUESTIONS  
2011**

**General #1** -- As a Council Member you will be required to attend meetings throughout the day and evening hours. Does your schedule allow you to attend special meetings that may be called on short notice, as well as, full day and out of town meetings?

Yes, I can attend all meetings as I am retired and my schedule is very flexible. I do attend the Prescott Lions Club lunch meeting on Wednesday and volunteer at Yavapai Regional Medical Center, East Campus on Thursday morning.

**#2** - What special experiences enable you to be an effective Council Member?

I have been President of Park Ridge at Viewpoint North H.O.A. Prescott Valley, the past 5 years. I am a current member of the Prescott Noon Lions Club and a Guiding Lion for the newly formed Prescott Valley Mid-Day Lions. I was on the road and landscape committee; 4 years in the Hidden Valley Ranch H.O.A. Prescott. While living in Simi Valley California I was president of the Montgomery Ranch H.O.A, for 8 years and Vice President of Lusk Homes H.O.A. for 8 years. I was appointed by the Simi Valley City Council to the Neighborhood Council and held the position for 2 years. I was a member of the Special Education Committee for the Simi Valley Unified School District, with an appointment for 1 year. I was appointed by the Simi Valley City Council to update and review the Cities 5 year General Plan. I've been an associate of the PTA, Indian Guides and Cub Scouts.

**Role #1** -- What do you consider an appropriate relationship between the Council and staff?

There are many important matters that face the Town of Prescott Valley. Water may be the most important issue, followed by more job opportunities, business growth and housing. The economic and financial issues of the community are of major concern in providing services for the town.

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**#2** -- Based on the current economic conditions, how should Prescott Valley position itself for the future?

Prescott Valley must continue to use sound financial planning, keeping operating costs down and by using sensible judgment in areas of expenses while still providing the basic services for the community. We must also, as mentioned before, seek out to increase and to develop a larger industrial base for our community.
