SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Yavapai County is presently divided into three (3) Board of Supervisor Districts. Arizona State Law requires counties with a population of 175,000 or more to have five (5) supervisorial districts. Based on the 2010 census, Yavapai County will move to a five (5) member Board of Supervisors with the term beginning January 2013. Information is being provided to Council in the attached report for the purpose of understanding how new Supervisor Districts will be selected and how the proposed districts and Prescott Valley population may be aligned within the Town Limits.
