SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: AZLink is a statewide law enforcement program constructed by Knowledge Computing Corporation that enables local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies to share information about crime and criminal activities. The Maricopa County Sheriff's office has been designated as the Subgrantee agency for reimbursement of funds for AZLink from the State Homeland Security Grant Program of the Arizona Department of Homeland Security.

On November 7, 2010, the Council approved the original Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for the Police Department to join as a client agency in AZLink program with Maricopa County. For unconfirmed reasons, the former Police Chief canceled our participation before the agreement was executed. The Subgrantee agency has secured an extension of September 30, 2011, to allow our participation.

The attached IGA again sets forth the funding available to Prescott Valley Police Department to address the cost of acquiring and maintaining the required hardware and software. The total cost of \$45,000 associated with the program is divided equally between the Prescott Valley Police Department, and the Prescott Police Department. The amount of \$22,500 would now be available via the Council action.

OPTION ANALYSIS: The Council may vote to:

- 1.) Approve this IGA that provides \$22,500 in grant funding for participation in AZLink, **OR**
- 2.) Not approve this IGA, **AND/OR**
- 3.) Direct staff to pursue other options

ACTION OPTION: Motion to approve this Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for grant funding for participation in AZLink. **VOTE**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of this second Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for grant funding for participation in AZLink.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: The costs associated with this segment of the AZLink program implementation are of the amounts approved from prior discussions and known to be available by grant funding.
