

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**SUMMARY BACKGROUND:** This project, in general, is for rehabilitation of three water storage tanks located at the Tank Farm. This work involves pressure washing and reapplication of exterior coatings on the three tanks and the adjacent booster pump station buildings. The tanks are located approximately 1.25 miles north of East State Route 69, at the north end of Prescott East Highway and slightly west of the Granville community. Exterior coating is required to protect the tanks against corrosion and for aesthetic purposes. The tanks were inspected in November 2005 by Utility Service Co. Incorporated and the reports indicate that new coatings are necessary.

This project was scheduled to be performed in the next budget cycle (FY 2012/2013), however, the solar “Power Purchase Agreement” (PPA) is being planned for the Tank Farm later this year and application of tank coating prior to placing the solar arrays in October will minimize concerns with regard to paint overspray.

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**FISCAL ANALYSIS:** Since this project was not originally considered for the current budget year, a budget adjustment is required as shown in the fiscal analysis below. Funds will be transferred from the Fire Hydrant Program and distributed between the Tank Farm Exterior Coating Project and the Valve Rehabilitation Program. The shift of funds will have some impact on the hydrant program, however, installation and replacement of said infrastructure is also conducted under the annual Valve Installation and Replacement Program and its funding has increased by \$40,000.00 from previous years.
