SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: The Prescott Valley Military Service Monument Committee has been busy for the past five years raising funds to construct a military monument in Prescott Valley to honor past, present, and future members of our armed forces.

The Town agreed at the outset to allow this group of volunteers to finance and construct the improvements on designated Town property on the Civic Center campus and to ultimately accept and maintain the improvements.

The Committee broke ground on November 11, 2009 and completed the Monument in August of this year. It is now proposed that the Town accept the improvements and agree to maintain them for future generations to enjoy.



OPTIONS ANALYSIS: Council may vote to accept the Monument as constructed for future maintenance or decline to accept the Monument at this time.

ACTION OPTION: Motion to authorize the Mayor (or, in his absence, the Vice Mayor) to sign Resolution No. 1762 accepting the Prescott Valley Military Service Monument as constructed for future maintenance, **OR** Motion not to approve Resolution No. 1762. **VOTE.**

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends authorizing signature of Resolution No. 1762 accepting the Monument.

FISCAL ANALYSIS: There will be some minor annual expenses to maintain the Monument, including flag & bulb replacements, insurance, and general upkeep.
