

RESOLUTION NO. 1762

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ARIZONA, ACCEPTING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS ON DESIGNATED TOWN PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE "PRESCOTT VALLEY MILITARY SERVICE MONUMENT" FOR FUTURE MAINTENANCE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, a group of citizen volunteers known as the Prescott Valley Military Service Monument Committee was formed in December 2006 with the intent to build a monument to honor past, present, and future members of the U.S. military; and

WHEREAS, the Town agreed to allow the Committee to finance through private sources and then ultimately construct said monument on designated Town property located on the Civic Center campus; and

WHEREAS, the Committee worked diligently over the past five years to design and raise private funds for the monument, including selling bricks in honor of military service members and hosting public events; and

WHEREAS, the Committee arranged for construction and eventually broke ground for the monument on Veteran's Day, November 11, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the finishing touches to what is now designated as the "Prescott Valley Military Service Monument" have been made; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires now to accept for future maintenance these fixtures which have been built into Town property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PRESCOTT VALLEY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. That the Town hereby commends the past and present members of the Prescott Valley Military Service Monument Committee for their tireless efforts in designing, financing, and constructing the Prescott Valley Military Service Monument.

SECTION TWO. That the Town hereby agrees to accept and maintain the Monument and its related improvements in honor of the service members who have fought for our country, both past, present, and future.

SECTION THREE. That this Resolution shall be effective after its passage and approval according to law.
