

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**SUMMARY BACKGROUND:** The Yavapai County Flood Control District (YCFCD) levies a tax countywide for storm water management projects to improve storm water conveyance. The Town cooperates with YCFCD yearly through an Intergovernmental Agreement to design and construct storm water management projects that benefit the Town of Prescott Valley. One of the projects identified this year for funding is Phase 2 of the Western Blvd. area storm management improvements project. Design has been completed by Lyon Engineering and the project is ready for construction.

This request is for approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement with Yavapai County for \$600,000 of funding for Phase 2 of the Western Blvd. Storm Water Management Improvement project.



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**OPTION ANALYSIS:** The Council may vote to:

- 1.) Approve the Intergovernmental Agreement, **OR**
- 2.) Not approve the Intergovernmental Agreement, **AND/OR**
- 3.) Direct staff to pursue other options

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**ACTION OPTION:** Motion to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement with Yavapai County Flood Control District for 100% funding for the Western Blvd. Storm Water Management Project, CIP # E328.2, in a total amount of \$600,000 **OR** not approve the Intergovernmental Agreement. **VOTE.**

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement in the amount of \$600,000 which would provide 100% of the funds necessary for the storm water management improvements.

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**FISCAL ANALYSIS:** There is no direct fiscal impact to the Town as a result of approving this agreement.
