SUMMARY BACKGROUND: The 2006 Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization (CYMPO) Regional Transportation Study recommended a future roadway network comprised of local and regional roads to meet 2030 travel demands. One of the proposed new roads identified in the study was a connector between SR 169 and Fain Road. The subsequent SR 169 to Fain Road Planning Study (February 2009) established a preferred corridor for the new access-controlled roadway. Then, in September 2010 the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) initiated a further study through the I-17 to Fain Road Connector Corridor Location Study and Environmental Overview to specifically identify traffic interchange locations for local access.

A public meeting to solicit comment was conducted by ADOT in Prescott Valley on September 28, 2011 to present the Northern Study Area and five (5) alternatives detailing options for interchange locations and local access. Town staff's recommendation for the best alternative is option Alternative 1 or Alternative 1A.
